

Directions to the SLKA track:

The SLKA track is located 30 minutes south of downtown St. Louis on Interstate 55 at Pevely exits 180 & 178.

- When coming from the north, take I-55 to Missouri Hwy Z (exit #180), then go east on Hwy Z to US Hwy 61/67, then go south on US Hwy 61/67 two miles to Herky-Horine Rd., then go 1 mile west on Herky-Horine Rd. to the track.
- When coming from the south, take exit #178 and go east to the second traffic light which is Hwy 61/67. Turn north on Hwy 61/67 and go approximately 1 mile and turn left on Herky-Horine Rd. Proceed down Herky-Horine Road for approximately 1 mile until you reach the track.

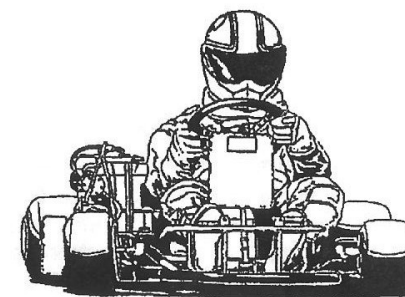
